The term does not include: 20 21 (a) An ammunition-feeding device that has been 22 permanently altered so that it cannot accommodate more than 10 23 rounds of ammunition; or (b) Any .22 caliber tube ammunition-feeding device. 24 25 (3) Any person who violates this section commits a felony of the second degree, punishable as provided in section 26 27 775.082, section 775.083, or section 775.084, Florida 28 Statutes. 29 Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2000. 30 31

SENATE SUMMARY Provides that it is a third-degree felony to manufacture, import, sell, or possess a large-capacity ammunition magazine. Defines the term "large-capacity ammunition magazine" to mean any ammunition-feeding device that has a capacity of more than 10 rounds of ammunition. Provides certain exceptions.
