An act relating to the "One-Florida

Initiative"; expressing the legislative intent
to retain statutory goals on the participation
of minority business enterprises in state
contracting; providing for the creation,
membership, and purpose of the Commission on
Minority-Business-Enterprise Contracting;
requiring a report; providing an effective
date.

WHEREAS, the Legislature has established in the Florida Statutes spending goals for state-agency contracts with certified minority business enterprises, and

WHEREAS, the Governor has unveiled a "One-Florida Initiative" that seeks to prohibit many state agencies from using racial or gender considerations or goals when making state-contracting decisions, and

WHEREAS, the Legislature finds that such contracting goals are laudable and necessary to address disparity among minority and nonminority businesses for contracts with the state and its agencies, and

WHEREAS, the Legislature will consider elimination of such statutorily prescribed goals only upon the finding of an objective commission that such goals are not enhancing the participation of minority business enterprises in state contracting and are not necessary to prevent or remedy discrimination against minority business enterprises in state contracting decisions, NOW, THEREFORE,

retain the goals established in section 287.09451, Florida
Statutes, governing state-agency contracts with certified
minority business enterprises. It also is the intent of the
Legislature to consider elimination of such goals at a future
date, if such elimination is warranted based on the findings
and recommendations of an objective commission. It further is
the intent of the Legislature to ensure that state agencies
continue to follow these goals and to ensure that these goals
are used to measure and evaluate the contracting activities of
state agencies.

Section 2. Commission on Minority-Business-Enterprise Contracting; creation; purpose; membership. -- There is created the Commission on Minority-Business-Enterprise Contracting, to be composed of members appointed by the Governor, the President of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives. The purpose of the commission is to study the participation of minority business enterprises in contracting activities of the state and to issue a report to the Governor, the President of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives by December 1, 2000. The report shall include a recommendation on whether the Legislature should eliminate the goals established in section 287.09451, Florida Statutes, governing the participation of minority business enterprises in state contracts. If the commission recommends elimination of such goals, the report shall include recommendations for alternative means to evaluate agency activities and to prevent discrimination against minority business enterprises in state contracting decisions.

Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a
