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A bill to be entitled
An act relating to review of mandated health coverage; providing an appropriation to the Office of Legislative Services for a systematic review of current mandated health coverages in accordance with the intent and guidelines of s. 624.215, F.S.; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. The sum of \$200,000 is appropriated from the Insurance Commissioner's Regulatory Trust Fund to the Office of Legislative Services for the purpose of implementing the legislative intent expressed in s. 624.215(1), Florida Statutes, for a systematic review of current mandated health coverages. The review must be conducted by certified actuaries and other appropriate professionals and shall consist of an assessment of the impact of current mandated health coverages using the guidelines provided in s. 624.215(2), Florida Statutes. This assessment shall establish the aggregate cost of mandated health coverages.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2000.
