The codification or restatement of existing statutory language shall not be construed as a grant of any additional authority or restriction of authority of any other governmental entity pursuant to general law. However, specific exceptions to law contained in any special act which are merely recodified shall continue to apply. The Legislature may adopt a schedule for individual district codification. Any codified act relating to a district, which act is submitted to the Legislature for reenactment, shall provide for the repeal of all prior special

Section 2. Section 191.015, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

191.015 Codification. -- Each fire control district existing on the effective date of this section, by December 1, 2004, shall submit to the Legislature a draft codified charter, at its expense, so that its special acts may be codified into a single act for reenactment by the Legislature, if there is more than one special act for the district. The codification or restatement of existing statutory language shall not be construed as a grant of any additional authority or restriction of authority of any other governmental entity pursuant to general law. However, specific exceptions to law contained in any special act which are merely recodified shall continue to apply. The Legislature may adopt a schedule for individual district codification. Any codified act relating to a district, which act is submitted to the Legislature for reenactment, shall provide for the repeal of all prior special acts of the Legislature relating to the district. The codified act shall be filed with the Department of Community Affairs pursuant to s. 189.418(2).

Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.

HOUSE SUMMARY

Provides that the codification or restatement of existing statutory language contained in the codified charters of special districts under chapters 189 and 191, F.S., shall not be construed as a grant of additional authority or a restriction of authority of any other governmental entity pursuant to general law.
