17	Section 2. <u>Effective July 1, 2000, for the period July</u>		
18	<u>1, 1998, through June 30, 1999, every business classified</u>		
19	<u>under Industry Group Number 212, which has collected and paid</u>		
20	<u>tax imposed by chapter 212, Florida Statutes, on charges for</u>		
21	<u>steam or electrical energy used in the manner provided by</u>		
22	<u>section 212.08(7)(ii), Florida Statutes, shall qualify for a</u>		
23	<u>refund of said taxes pursuant to sections 213.255 and 215.26,</u>		
24	<u>Florida Statutes, or shall be relieved of the requirement to</u>		
25	<u>pay such taxes if those taxes have not been collected and</u>		
26	<u>paid. It is the intent of the Legislature that this provision</u>		
27	<u>shall be applied as if Industry Group Number 212 had never</u>		
28	<u>been excluded from this exemption. As used in this section,</u>		
29	<u>the term "SIC" means those classifications contained in the</u>		
30	<u>Standard Industrial Classification Manual, 1987, as published</u>		
31	<u>by the Office of Management and Budget, Executive Office of</u>		

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1 the President.

2 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2000,
3 except that section 1 of this act shall take effect January 1,
4 2001.
