At least 4 30 Thirty percent of the total allocation provided to the 5 trust shall be used in Standard Metropolitan Statistical 6 Areas, but one-half of that amount shall be used in localities 7 in which the project site is located in built-up commercial, industrial, or mixed-use areas and functions to intersperse 8 9 open spaces within congested urban core areas. From funds 10 allocated to the trust, no less than 5 percent shall be used to acquire lands for recreational trail systems, provided that 11 12 in the event these funds are not needed for such projects, they will be available for other trust projects.
