Amendment to Amendment (835921) (with title amendment)

Remove from the bill: Everything after the enacting clause
and insert in lieu thereof:

Section 1. (1) For the period beginning at 12:01 a.m. July 1, 2000, through midnight, July 31, 2000, no taxes shall be collected on diapers and incontinence undergarments under chapter 212, Florida Statutes.

(2) Taxes administered on sales of diapers and incontinence undergarments during the period from 12:01 a.m. August 1, 2000, through midnight, June 30, 2001, shall be collected as stated in chapter 212, Florida Statutes, except that such revenues shall be designated to provide funding for public school teacher salaries.

(3) The provisions of chapter 120, Florida Statutes, to the contrary notwithstanding, the Department of Revenue may adopt rules to carry out this section.

Section 2. This act shall shall take effect upon becoming law.
