(1) The provisions of a property insurance policy which exclude coverage based on a pollution exclusion 10 clause for bodily injury or property damage caused in whole or 11 in part by the actual, alleged, or threatened discharge, 12 dispersal, seepage, migration, release, or escape of 13 pollutants at any time, apply only to damages caused by 14 serious environmental harm. 15 (2) As used in this section, the term "pollutants" 16 means any solid, liquid, gaseous, or thermal irritant or 17 contaminant, including smoke, vapor, soot, fumes, acid, 18 19 alkalis, chemicals, and waste recognized by government 20 regulators or the industry as a whole to be a toxic or particularly harmful material. 21 22 Section 2.
