Paragraph (d) of subsection (2) of section 110.205, Florida Statutes, is amended to read: 18 19 110.205 Career service; exemptions.--20 (2) EXEMPT POSITIONS.--The exempt positions which are 21 not covered by this part include the following, provided that 22 no position, except for positions established for a limited period of time pursuant to paragraph (h), shall be exempted if 23 the position reports to a position in the career service: 24 25 (d) All officers and employees of the State University 26 System, and the Correctional Education Program within the 27 Department of Corrections, and the academic personnel and 28 academic administrative personnel of the Florida School for 29 the Deaf and the Blind. In accordance with the provisions of 30 chapter 242, the salaries for officers and employees academic 31 personnel and academic administrative personnel of the Florida 1

1 School for the Deaf and the Blind shall be set by the board of trustees for the school, subject only to the approval of the 2 3 State Board of Education. Section 2.
