A bill to be entitled  
An act relating to the Florida School for the Deaf and the Blind; directing the Department of Management Services and the Florida School for the Deaf and the Blind to develop a report and recommendation; providing for its submission by January 1, 2001; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. The Department of Management Services, in cooperation with the Florida School for the Deaf and the Blind, shall develop and implement a specialized training program for career service, nonteaching employees who deal with visually impaired and hearing impaired students. The program shall include a revised classification and pay grade component that will permit retention and recruitment of employees with special skills. The department and the school shall provide a report and recommendation by January 1, 2001.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2000.

STATEMENT OF SUBSTANTIAL CHANGES CONTAINED IN  
COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR  
Senate Bill 2572

The Committee Substitute replaces the provisions of the filed bill with a requirement that the Department of Management Services and the School for the Deaf and Blind issue a report and recommendation on a revised classification and pay plan for employees who deal with visually and hearing impaired students.
