Section 2. The Department of Community Affairs, in conjunction with the Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development, the Office of Urban Opportunities, and Enterprise Florida, Inc., shall recommend new economic incentives or revisions to existing economic incentives in order to promote the reuse of vacant industrial and manufacturing facilities for affordable housing and mixed-use development. The report must also identify any state regulatory or programmatic barriers to the reuse of such facilities. The department shall submit a report to the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives containing its recommendations by January 31, 2001. Based upon consultation with the Department of Environmental Protection, the department shall include, as a component of the report, any
