A bill to be entitled 1 2 An act relating to lighthouses; directing the 3 Department of Community Affairs and the 4 Department of State to conduct a study of 5 lighthouses in the state; providing for 6 planning and funding responsibilities; 7 directing each department to make a budget request for funding purposes; providing an 8 9 effective date. 10 11 WHEREAS, Florida is a maritime state and has depended 12 on the sea for commerce and transportation throughout its 13 history, and 14 WHEREAS, lighthouses have facilitated that maritime development, saving many lives and vessels, and 15 16 WHEREAS, many historic lighthouses in this state are in 17 poor and unstable condition, and WHEREAS, it is declared to be the public policy of the 18 19 state to identify historic lighthouses, assess their 20 condition, stabilize them, and make them available to the 21 public in recognition of the history and heritage of Florida, 22 NOW, THEREFORE, 23 24 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida: 25 26 Section 1. (1) The Coastal Management Program of the 27 Department of Community Affairs and the Division of Historical 28 Resources of the Department of State shall undertake a study 29 of the lighthouses in the state. The study must determine the 30 location, ownership, condition, and historical significance of all lighthouses in the state and ensure that all historically

Significant lighthouses are nominated for inclusion on the National Register of Historic Places. The study must assess the condition and restoration needs of historic lighthouses and develop plans for appropriate future public access and use. The Coastal Management Program and the Division of Historical Resources shall take a leadership role in implementing plans to stabilize lighthouses and associated structures and to preserve and protect them from future deterioration. When possible, the lighthouses and associated buildings should be made available to the public for educational and recreational purposes. The Department of Community Affairs should consider these responsibilities to be a priority of the Florida Coastal Management Program and implementation of this act should be a priority in the use of Coastal Management funds.

(2) The Department of Community Affairs and the Department of State shall request in their annual legislative budget requests funding necessary to carry out the duties and responsibilities specified in this act. Funds for the rehabilitation of lighthouses should be allocated through matching grants-in-aid to state and local government agencies and to nonprofit organizations. The Department of Community Affairs may assist the Division of Historical Resources in projects to accomplish lighthouse identification, assessment, restoration, and interpretation.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
