A bill to be entitled
An act relating to the Barron Water Control
District of Glades and Hendry Counties;
extending the corporate life of the district
until midnight September 30, 2020; providing an
effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. (1) In order for the Barron Water Control
District of Glades and Hendry Counties to raise funds,
complete its water management plan, pay for works already
completed, pay principal or interest on its bonds, restore any
works, and construct new works, it is desirable to extend the
time for which the district has been incorporated.

(2) The Barron Water Control District of Glades and
Hendry Counties which, under the terms of the "Order Granting
Petition for the Formation of a Water Management District,"
entered on May 8, 1975, by the Circuit Court of the 20th
Judicial Circuit in and for Hendry County, in case No. 72-197,
styled "In Re: Barron Water Management District," was to cease
to exist on May 7, 2005, shall, instead, cease to exist at
midnight September 30, 2020.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a
law.
