A bill to be entitled
An act relating to Monroe County; authorizing
said county to enact amendments to
comprehensive plans more frequently than twice
a year under certain circumstances; providing
an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 163.3187(1)(c)1.e., Florida Statutes, the Monroe County Board of County Commissioners may adopt amendments to the comprehensive plan more than two times during any calendar year if the amendments are directly related to a proposed small-scale-development activity that involves affordable housing and otherwise comply with the remaining provisions of section 163.3187, Florida Statutes.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
