9	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

11	Section 1. The present corporate limits of the City of
12	Deerfield Beach, Broward County, Florida, are hereby extended
13	and enlarged so as to include, in addition to the territory
14	presently within its corporate limits, that portion of parcel
15	"A", "J.F.C. Plat", according to the plat thereof, recorded in
16	Plat Book 133, Page 35 of the Public Records of Broward
17	County, Florida, lying Northerly of that road easement for
18	Sample Road as shown on said plat.

Section 3. On the effective date of this act, the City of Deerfield Beach shall be responsible for and embodied with all municipal powers granted in chapter 166, Florida Statutes, over territory hereby annexed. Section 4. Nothing in this chapter shall be construed to affect or abrogate the rights of parties to any contracts, whether the same be between Broward County and a third party or between nongovernmental entities, which contracts are in effect prior to the effective date of annexation. Section 5. This act shall take effect September 15, 2000.
