WHEREAS, Robert K. Gross was born on June 3, 1958, and WHEREAS, Robert K. Gross served as an Executive Board member of the National Postgraduate Committee from 1990-1993, and

WHEREAS, Robert K. Gross was Governor of the London School of Economics from 1992-1993, and

WHEREAS, Robert K. Gross taught Broward County children at Pine Crest Preparatory School from 1993-1996, and

WHEREAS, Robert K. Gross was appointed as an at-large member to the Broward County Democratic Executive Committee from 1994-1996, and

WHEREAS, Robert K. Gross served on the City of Hollywood's Beach Master Plan Committee from 1995-1996, and

WHEREAS, Robert K. Gross was an adjunct professor at the Florida International University in the Masters in Environmental and Urban Systems program from 1996-1997, and

WHEREAS, Robert K. Gross worked with the Broward Employment and Training Administration to promote transportation, education, and school-to-career programs from 1997-1999, and

WHEREAS, Robert K. Gross was the Broward County Democratic Executive Committee Committeeman from 1997-1999, and

WHEREAS, Robert K. Gross was a member of the Broward Community Involvement Round Table from 1997-1999, and

WHEREAS, Robert K. Gross was on the Executive Board of the Broward County Young Democrats from 1995-1999, served as
