Subsection (1) of section 561.501, Florida Statutes, is amended to read: 11 12 561.501 Surcharge on sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption on the premises; penalty .--13 14 (1) Notwithstanding s. 561.50 or any other provision of the Beverage Law, a surcharge of 6.67 cents is imposed upon 15 each ounce of liquor and each 4 ounces of wine, a surcharge of 16 4 cents is imposed on each 12 ounces of cider, and a surcharge 17 of 2.67 cents is imposed on each 12 ounces of beer sold at 18 19 retail for consumption on premises licensed by the division as 20 an alcoholic beverage vendor. However, the surcharges imposed 21 under this subsection need not be paid upon such beverages 22 when they are sold by an organization that is licensed by the division under s. 565.02(4) or s. 561.422 as an alcoholic 23 beverage vendor and that is determined by the Internal Revenue 24 25 Service to be currently exempt from federal income tax under 26 s. 501(c)(3) or (19) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as 27 amended. 28 Section 2.
