14 designating new classroom and office space for
15 the College of Business at Florida Atlantic
16 University's Boca Raton Campus as the "Carl
17 DeSantis Pavilion"; designating the new
18 presidential residence at Florida Atlantic
19 University's Boca Raton Campus as the "Eleanor
20 R. Baldwin House"; designating Academic
21 Building #2 at Florida Gulf Coast University as
22 "Charles B. Reed Hall"; designating the Student
23 Services Building at Florida Gulf Coast
24 University as "Roy E. McTarnaghan Hall";
25 designating the Seminole Golf Course at Florida
26 State University as the "Don A. Veller Seminole
27 Golf Course"; designating Building #76 at
28 Florida State University as "William A. Tanner
29 Hall"; designating Building #1012 on the Panama
30 City Campus of Florida State University as the
31 "Larson M. Bland Conference Center";

2 Seminole Golf Course at Florida State
3 University as the "David Middleton Golf
4 Center"; designating the Administration
5 Building at the University of Central Florida
6 as "Millican Hall"; designating the Humanities
7 and Fine Arts Building at the University of
8 Central Florida as "Colbourn Hall"; designating
9 the facility to house the Honors College at the
10 University of Central Florida as "Burnett
11 Hall"; designating the Cancer Center at the
12 University of Florida as the "Jerry W. and
13 Judith S. Davis Cancer Center"; designating the
14 University Athletic Center at the University of
15 Florida as the "L. Gale Lemerand Athletics
16 Center"; designating the tennis facility at the
17 University of Florida as the "Alfred A. Ring
18 Tennis Complex"; designating the Center for the
19 Performing Arts at the University of Florida as
20 the "Curtis M. Phillips Center for the
21 Performing Arts"; designating the Golf
22 Management and Learning Center at the
23 University of North Florida as the "John and
24 Geraldine Hayt Golf Management and Learning
25 Center"; designating the student residence
26 currently known as Gamma Hall at the University
27 of South Florida as "Betty Castor Hall";
28 designating the IFAS North Florida Research and
29 Education Center as the "Fount May, Sr.,
30 Research Center"; designating the School of
31 Architecture building at the University Park

1 Campus of the Florida International University
2 as the "Paul L. Cejas School of Architecture
3 Building"; designating the new residence hall
4 at the University of West Florida as "John G.
5 Martin Hall"; designating certain property at
6 University Drive and Pembroke Road in Pembroke
7 Pines as the Senator Howard C. Forman Human
8 Services Campus"; authorizing the erection of
9 suitable markers; designating the renovated
10 student services area at the University of
11 Central Florida as the "Jimmy A. Ferrell
12 Student Services Commons"; designating the
13 state veterans' home in Pembroke Pines as the
14 "Alexander 'Sandy' Nininger, Jr., State
15 Veterans' Nursing Home"; designating the Bartow
16 Agricultural Center as the "Bob Crawford
17 Agricultural Center;" designating the Science
18 and Education Building at the Southeast Campus
19 of Florida Atlantic University in Davie as the
20 "Senator James A. Scott Building"; designating
21 a bridge on the Jensen Beach Causeway in Martin
22 County as the "Frank Wacha Bridge"; authorizing
23 the respective universities to erect suitable
24 markers; providing an effective date.

26 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

27

28 Section 1. The baseball field at Florida A & M
29 University is hereby designated as the "Oscar A. Moore-Costa
30 Kittles Baseball Field."

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1 Section 2. The tennis courts at Florida A & M
2 University are hereby designated as the "Althea Gibson Tennis
3 Courts."

4 Section 3. The Athletic Center at Florida Atlantic
5 University's Boca Raton Campus is hereby designated as the
6 "Tom Oxley Athletic Center and Fields."

7 Section 4. A new Fine Arts Building at Florida
8 Atlantic University's John D. MacArthur Campus in Jupiter is
9 hereby designated as the "Hibel Fine Arts Building" in
10 recognition of Edna Hibel.

11 Section 5. New classroom and office space for the
12 College of Business at Florida Atlantic University's Boca
13 Raton Campus is hereby designated as the "Carl DeSantis
14 Pavilion."

15 Section 6. The new presidential residence at Florida
16 Atlantic University's Boca Raton Campus is hereby designated
17 as the "Eleanor R. Baldwin House."

18 Section 7. Academic Building #2, which houses the
19 Colleges of Arts & Sciences and Business at Florida Gulf Coast
20 University, is hereby designated as "Charles B. Reed Hall" in
21 recognition of the former chancellor of the State University
22 System of Florida.

23 Section 8. The Student Services Building at Florida
24 Gulf Coast University is hereby designated as the "Roy E.
25 McTarnaghan Hall" in recognition of the founding president of
26 Florida Gulf Coast University.

27 Section 9. The Seminole Golf Course at Florida State
28 University is hereby designated as the "Don A. Veller Seminole
29 Golf Course."

30 Section 10. Building #76 at Florida State University
31 is hereby designated as "William A. Tanner Hall."

1 Section 11. Building #1012, located on the Panama City
2 Campus of Florida State University, is hereby designated as
3 the "Larson M. Bland Conference Center."

4 Section 12. The new clubhouse building at the Seminole
5 Golf Course at Florida State University is hereby designated
6 as the "David Middleton Golf Center."

7 Section 13. The building known as the Administration
8 Building located at the University of Central Florida is
9 hereby designated as "Millican Hall" in recognition of Dr.
10 Charles N. Millican, the founding president of the University
11 of Central Florida.

12 Section 14. The building known as the Humanities and
13 Fine Arts Building at the University of Central Florida is
14 hereby designated as "Colbourn Hall" in recognition of Dr.
15 Trevor Colbourn, the second president of the University of
16 Central Florida.

17 Section 15. The facility to house the Honors College
18 at the University of Central Florida is hereby designated as
19 "Burnett Hall."

20 Section 16. The Cancer Center at the University of
21 Florida is hereby designated as the "Jerry W. and Judith S.
22 Davis Cancer Center."

23 Section 17. The University Athletic Center at the
24 University of Florida is hereby designated as the "L. Gale
25 Lemerand Athletics Center."

26 Section 18. The tennis facility at the University of
27 Florida is hereby designated as the "Alfred A. Ring Tennis
28 Complex."

29 Section 19. The Center for the Performing Arts at the
30 University of Florida is hereby designated as the "Curtis M.
31 Phillips Center for the Performing Arts."

1 Section 20. The Golf Management and Learning Center at
2 the University of North Florida is hereby designated as the
3 "John and Geraldine Hayt Golf Management and Learning Center."

4 Section 21. The student residence at the University of
5 South Florida currently known as Gamma Hall is hereby
6 designated as "Betty Castor Hall," in recognition of the fifth
7 president of the University of South Florida.

8 Section 22. The IFAS North Florida Research and
9 Education Center located at Quincy, Florida, is designated as
10 the "Fount May, Sr., Research Center."

11 Section 23. Senator Howard C. Forman Human Services
12 Campus designation; markers.--

13 (1) The property on University Drive and Pembroke Road
14 in Pembroke Pines, upon which the state mental institution,
15 the state veterans' home, and other human services
16 institutions are located, is hereby designated as the Senator
17 Howard C. Forman Human Services Campus.

18 (2) The Department of Children and Family Services is
19 authorized to erect suitable markers for the "Senator Howard
20 C. Forman Human Services Campus designation made by subsection
21 (1).

22 Section 24. The School of Architecture building at the
23 University Park Campus of the Florida International University
24 is hereby designated as the "Paul L. Cejas School of
25 Architecture Building."

26 Section 25. The new residence hall at the University
27 of West Florida is hereby designated as "John G. Martin Hall."

28 Section 26. The renovated student services area at the
29 University of Central Florida is hereby designated as the
30 "Jimmy A. Ferrell Student Services Commons."

1 Section 27. The state veterans' home in Pembroke Pines
2 is hereby designated as the "Alexander 'Sandy' Nininger, Jr.,
3 State Veterans' Nursing Home."

4 Section 28. The respective universities set forth in
5 this act are authorized to erect suitable markers for the
6 designations made by this act.

7 Section 29. The Bartow Agricultural Center is hereby
8 redesignated as the "Bob Crawford Agricultural Center."

9 Section 30. The Science and Education Building at the
10 Southeast Campus of Florida Atlantic University in Davie is
11 renamed the "Senator James A. Scott Building."

12 Section 31. Frank Wacha Bridge designation; markers.--

13 (1) The bridge on the Jensen Beach Causeway in Martin
14 County is hereby designated as the "Frank Wacha Bridge."

15 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
16 erect suitable markers designating the "Frank Wacha Bridge" as
17 described in subsection (1).

18 Section 32. This act shall take effect upon becoming a
19 law.
