The Social Services Estimating Conference shall 21 develop such official information relating to the social 22 services system of the state, including forecasts of social services and Medicaid caseloads, as the conference determines 23 is needed for the state planning and budgeting system. 24 Such 25 official information shall include, but need not be limited to, subsidized child care caseloads mandated by the Family 26 27 Support Act of 1988. In addition, the Social Services Estimating 28 2. Conference shall develop estimates and forecasts of the 29 30 unduplicated count of children eligible for subsidized child 31 care as defined in s. 402.3015(1). These estimates and 1

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1 forecasts shall not include children enrolled in the 2 prekindergarten early intervention program established in s. 3 230.2305. The Department of Children and Family Services and 4 3. 5 the Department of Education shall provide information on б caseloads and waiting lists for the subsidized child care and 7 prekindergarten early intervention programs requested by the Social Services Estimating Conference or individual conference 8 9 principals, in a timely manner. 10 4. The Department of Children and Family Services and the Department of Education shall provide information on 11 caseloads and waiting lists for people who have developmental 12 disabilities as they relate to individuals eligible for or 13 receiving services under the developmental services home and 14 15 community-based waiver program. The Social Services Estimating Conference shall use this and other pertinent data to estimate 16 17 the annual cost of providing home and community-based services. This estimate shall be included in the official 18 19 estimate produced by the conference. 20 Section 2.
