26	of such expenditures in the same manner, at the same time, and
27	with the same officer as a political committee supporting or

(candidate or committee)..., " and must 10 shall contain the name and address of the person paying for 11 the political advertisement. (2) Any person who fails to include the disclaimer 12 13 prescribed in subsection (1) in any political advertisement 14 that which is required to contain such disclaimer is guilty of 15 a misdemeanor of the first degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083. 16 17 (3) No person may make a contribution in excess of \$1,000 to any other person, to be used by such other person to 18 19 make an independent expenditure.
