21	<u>"A-B"-rated drug that is currently on the negative formulary</u>		
22	<u>created under that statute, a pharmacist must dispense the</u>		
23	<u>drug unless prior approval to substitute is obtained from the</u>		
24	<u>prescriber of the medication. Any refill thereunder of the</u>		
25	<u>initial prescription for such a drug must be refilled using</u>		
26	<u>only the same drug product by the same manufacturer which the</u>		
27	<u>pharmacist last dispensed under the prescription.</u>
