13	<b>Senate Amendment (with title amendment)</b>		
14	On page 1, lines 14 through 28, delete those lines,		
15			
16	and insert:		
17	Section 1. <u>The Board of Medicine, the Board of</u>		
18	<u>Osteopathic Medicine, and the Board of Pharmacy must jointly</u>		
19	<u>submit a report to the Legislature by January 1, 2002, which</u>		
20	<u>recommends whether the formulary for generic and brand-name</u>		
21	<u>drugs required by section 465.025(6), Florida Statutes, should</u>		
22	<u>be retained. The boards shall use their scientific knowledge</u>		
23	<u>and experience in compiling the report and shall consider all</u>		
24	<u>data in determining those measures that are needed to protect</u>		
25	<u>the health and safety of patients. The board may consider the</u>		
26	<u>bioequivalence of the drugs listed on the formulary and shall</u>		
27	<u>consider other factors involved with drug-product selection,</u>		
28	<u>the use of products by patients, the practice of pharmacy,</u>		
29	<u>publications of the Federal Food and Drug Administration, and</u>		
30	<u>adverse experience reports of the Federal Food and Drug</u>		
31	<u>Administration that they determine are relevant to the issues</u>
