18	<u>(5) For areas of the state not within the high</u>		
19	<u>velocity hurricane zone, the commission shall adopt, pursuant</u>		
20	<u>to s. 553.73, Florida Statutes, the wind protection</u>		
21	<u>requirements of the American Society of Civil Engineers,</u>		
22	<u>Standard 7, 1998 edition as implemented by the International</u>		
23	<u>Building Code, 2000 edition, and as modified by the commission</u>		
24	<u>in its February 15, 2000, adoption of the Florida Building</u>		
25	<u>Code for rule adoption by reference in Rule 9B-3.047, Florida</u>		
26	<u>Administrative Code. However, from the eastern border of</u>		
27	<u>Franklin County to the Florida-Alabama line, only land within</u>		
28	<u>1 mile of the coast shall be subject to the windborne-debris</u>		
29	<u>requirements adopted by the commission. The exact location of</u>		
30	<u>wind speed lines shall be established by local ordinance,</u>		
31	<u>using recognized physical landmarks such as major roads,</u>		

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1 canals, rivers, and lake shores, wherever possible. Buildings
2 constructed in the windborne debris region must be either
3 designed for internal pressures that may result inside a
4 building when a window or door is broken or a hole is created
5 in its walls or roof by large debris, or be designed with
6 protected openings. Except in the high velocity hurricane
7 zone, local governments may not prohibit the option of
8 designing buildings to resist internal pressures.
