The Community and Faith-based Organizations 19 Initiative. --20 (1) The Community and Faith-based Organizations 21 Initiative is created within the Institute on Urban Policy and 22 Commerce at Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University. 23 The purpose of the Community and Faith-based Organizations Initiative is to promote community development 24 in low-income communities through partnerships with community 25 26 and faith-based organizations. 27 The Community and Faith-based Organizations 2.8 Initiative shall include the following: 29 (a) Professional skill development, including the 30 creation and operation of training programs to enhance the 31

professional skills of individuals working within community and faith-based organizations.

- (b) The development of future leaders, including the creation and operation of a program to select and place students and recent graduates from the business school or related professional schools as interns with community and faith-based organizations for up to 1 year and to provide stipends for such interns.
- (c) The promotion of "best practices" through sponsorship of an annual conference for community and faith-based organizations to discuss and share information on best practices regarding issues relevant to the creation, operation, and sustainability of community and faith-based organizations.
- (d) The provision of funds to the Institute on Urban

 Policy and Commerce to develop materials for courses on topics

 in the area to conduct research on economic, operational, and

 policy issues that relate to community development.
- (4) In addition, the Community and Faith-based
 Organizations Initiative shall enhance partnerships and
 strategic alliances through providing financial assistance to
 community and faith-based organizations through small grants
 for the operation of partnerships with the Institute on Urban
 Policy and Commerce to build strong communities and future
 leaders in community development.
- Section 2. The sum of \$3 million is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Institute on Urban Policy and Commerce at Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University to fund the Community and Faith-based Organizations Initiative created by this act during the 2000-2001 fiscal year.
