26 Section 1. Subsection (13) of section 766.106, Florida
27 Statutes, is repealed.

28 Section 2. Section 768.151, Florida Statutes, is
29 repealed.

30 Section 3. Section 768.27, Florida Statutes, is
31 repealed.

- 1 Section 4. Section 768.30, Florida Statutes, is
- 2 repealed.
- 3 Section 5. Section 960.296, Florida Statutes, is
- 4 repealed.
- 5 Section 6. This act shall take effect upon becoming a
- 6 law.

18 date and applicability of the Florida Wrongful Death Act;
19 the effective dates and applicability of provisions
