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A bill to be entitled  
An act relating to the state group health insurance and prescription drug programs; authorizing specified local entities to contract for participation in the program; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. The governing body of a municipality, the governing body of a county, or the school board of a school district may contract annually with the Department of Management Services for participation in the state group health insurance benefits authorized in section 110.123, Florida Statutes, and prescription drug coverage authorized by section 110.12315, Florida Statutes, under the same terms and conditions as are provided to state officers and employees.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2000.

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SENATE SUMMARY

Provides that the governing body of a municipality or county or a district school board may contract for participation in the state group health insurance and state prescription drug programs.
