Amendment (with title amendment)

Remove from the bill: Everything after the enacting clause
and insert in lieu thereof:

Section 1. Subsection (13) is added to section 318.21, Florida Statutes, to read:

318.21 Disposition of civil penalties by county courts.--All civil penalties received by a county court pursuant to the provisions of this chapter shall be distributed and paid monthly as follows:

(13)(a) A municipality located in a county with a population of over 1 million people may, by a super majority (a majority plus one) vote of the governing board of the municipality, impose a surcharge of up to \$5 on the amount of civil penalties required under s. 318.18 for traffic infractions for the sole purpose of funding residential traffic calming programs. The surcharge may not be levied on traffic infractions occurring on any state road as defined by s. 316.003(50). The surcharge must be authorized by ordinance

2 (b) The proceeds of this surcharge shall be separately
3 accounted for by the governing body of the municipality and
4 may be distributed quarterly only to fund residential traffic
5 calming programs.
