Such standards and criteria shall 21 include, but are not limited to, exhaust emissions testing and 22 inspection procedures and the development of inspection pass 23 or fail criteria. Standards may vary by size, class, type, and 24 25 year of each motor vehicle engine and may not be more 26 stringent than those required by federal law at the time of 27 the manufacture of the motor vehicle. In establishing 28 standards and criteria, the Department of Environmental 29 Protection shall give consideration to levels of emissions reduction that are necessary to achieve applicable federal and 30 31 state air quality standards.
