1 expire upon the later of:

2       (a) Retirement of all bonds issued by the county for  
3 financing the same; or

4       (b) The expiration of any agreement by the county for  
5 the operation or maintenance, or both, of a publicly owned and  
6 operated convention center, sports stadium, sports arena,  
7 coliseum, auditorium, or museum.However, nothing herein shall  
8 preclude that county from amending the ordinance extending the  
9 tax to the extent that the board of the county determines to  
10 be necessary to provide funds with which to operate, maintain,  
11 repair, or renew and replace a publicly owned and operated  
12 convention center, sports stadium, sports arena, coliseum,  
13 auditorium, or museum or from enacting an ordinance pursuant  
14 to the provisions of this section reimposing a tourist  
15 development tax, upon or following the expiration of the  
16 previous ordinance.
