(1) The Operations and Maintenance Trust 24 25 Fund within the Department of Health, FLAIR number 64-2-516, 26 which is to be terminated pursuant to Section 19(f), Article 27 III of the State Constitution on July 1, 2001, is re-created. 28 (2) All current balances of the trust fund are carried forward, and all current sources and uses of the trust fund 29 30 are continued. 31
