# I. SUMMARY:

The bill provides for up to 25 percent of the distribution of the annual use fee of \$15 for the "Share the Road" license plate, as provided in s. 320.08058(31), F.S., to be distributed to Bike Florida, Inc., instead of going to the Florida Governor's Council on Physical Fitness and Amateur Sports.

The bill will become effective upon becoming law.

The bill does not have a fiscal impact on state or local governments.

#### B. PRESENT SITUATION:

Section 320.08056(4)(ee), F.S. provides that the annual use fee for the "Share the Road" license plate is \$15.

Section 320.08058(31), F.S. provides that the \$15 annual use fee is to be distributed to the Florida Governor's Council on Physical Fitness and Amateur Sports, with a portion being used for the marketing and promotion of the "Share the Road" concept. The provision provides for the remaining funds to be equally distributed to Bike Florida, Inc., and the Florida Bicycle Association, Inc. The provision further stipulates that these funds are to be used for bicycle and motorist safety education, awareness programs, and media events.

The Florida Governor's Council on Physical Fitness and Amateur Sports was repealed by section 10 of Chapter 99-251, Laws of Florida.

## C. EFFECT OF PROPOSED CHANGES:

The bill provides for up to 25 percent of the distribution of the annual use fee of \$15 for the "Share the Road" license plate, as provided in s. 320.08058(31), F.S., to be distributed to Bike Florida, Inc. instead of going to the Florida Governor's Council on Physical Fitness and Amateur Sports, which was abolished under Chapter 99-251, Laws of Florida. The bill's effective date is upon becoming law.

## D. SECTION-BY-SECTION ANALYSIS:

<u>Section 1</u> amends s. 320.08058, F.S., providing that the annual use fees shall be distributed to Bike Florida, Inc., up to 25 percent of which shall be used for marketing and promotion of the "Share the Road" concept and license plate. The remaining funds shall be divided equally between Bike Florida, Inc., and the Florida Bicycle Association, Inc., to be used for specified programs.
