I. SUMMARY:

The bill provides for up to 25 percent of the distribution of the annual use fee of \$15 for the "Share the Road" license plate, as provided in s. 320.08058(31), F.S., to be distributed to Bike Florida, Inc. in place of the Florida Governor's Council on Physical Fitness and Amateur Sports.

The bill will become effective upon becoming law.

The bill does not appear to have a fiscal impact on state or local governments.

B. PRESENT SITUATION:

Section 320.08056(4)(ee), F.S. provides that the annual use fee for the "Share the Road" license plate is \$15.

Section 320.08058(31), F.S. provides that the \$15 annual use fee is to be distributed to the Florida Governor's Council on Physical Fitness and Amateur Sports with a portion being used for the marketing and promotion of the "Share the Road" concept. The provision provides for the remaining funds to be equally distributed to Bike Florida, Inc. and the Florida Bicycle Association, Inc.. The provision further stipulates that these funds are to be used for bicycle and motorist safety education, awareness programs, and media events.

C. EFFECT OF PROPOSED CHANGES:

The bill provides for up to 25 percent of the distribution of the annual use fee of \$15 for the "Share the Road" license plate, as provided in s. 320.08058(31), F.S., to be distributed to Bike Florida, Inc. in place of the Florida Governor's Council on Physical Fitness and Amateur Sports, which was abolished under chapter 99-251, Laws of Florida.
