A bill to be entitled  
An act relating to the Florida Civil Rights  
Act; amending s. 760.02, F.S.; redefining the  
term "employer"; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (7) of section 760.02, Florida  
Statutes, is amended to read:

760.02 Definitions.--For the purposes of ss.  
760.01-760.11 and 509.092, the term:

(7) "Employer" means any person employing one ~~15~~ or  
more employees for each working day in each of 20 or more  
calendar weeks in the current or preceding calendar year, and  
any agent of such a person.

Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2000.

SENATE SUMMARY

Redefines the term "employer" to mean any person  
employing one or more employees, rather than 15 or more  
employees, for purposes of the Florida Civil Rights Act.
