Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 20, between lines 29 and 30,

insert:

(7) USE OF STUDENT DIRECTORY INFORMATION.--Pursuant to this section, personally identifiable information concerning a student in grades K through 12 is confidential and exempt from s. 119.07(1). However, notwithstanding paragraph (3)(f), each school district may publish and release to the Florida Education Foundation student directory information relating to a student in grades K through 12. Prior to the release of the information by a school district to the Florida Education Foundation, the parent must be notified in writing and provided the opportunity to withhold consent for such release. The Florida Education Foundation may, in its discretion, provide information and materials on behalf of any individual, agency, business, or organization directly to a student or parent whose directory information has been provided under this subsection.
