A bill to be entitled
An act relating to traffic violations;
requiring a law enforcement officer who
performs a traffic stop to inform the driver of
the motor vehicle the reason for the traffic
stop; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. When a law enforcement officer directs the driver of a motor vehicle to stop and present his or her driver's license and proof of insurance, the law enforcement officer must inform the driver of the reason for the traffic stop after the driver has presented his or her driver's license and proof of insurance.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2000.

SENATE SUMMARY

Requires that when a law enforcement officer performs a traffic stop, the officer must inform the driver of the reason for the traffic stop.
