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A bill to be entitled
An act relating to trust funds; terminating or
modifying specified trust funds administered by
state health and human services agencies;
providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. (1) The following trust funds administered
by the following agencies are terminated:

(a) Within the Department of Children and Family
Services, the Direct Assistance Trust Fund, FLAIR number
60-2-156.

(b) Within the Department of Veterans' Affairs, the
Administrative Trust Fund, FLAIR number 50-2-021.

(2) Unless otherwise provided, all current balances
remaining in, and all revenues of, the trust funds terminated
by this act shall be transferred to the General Revenue Fund.

(3) For each trust fund and fund account terminated by
this act, the agency that administers the trust fund or fund
account shall pay any outstanding debts or obligations of the
terminated fund or account as soon as practicable, and the
Comptroller shall close out and remove the terminated fund or
account from the various state accounting systems using
generally accepted accounting principles concerning warrants
outstanding, assets, and liabilities.

Section 2. The Child Care and Development Block Grant
Trust Fund within the Department of Children and Family
Services, FLAIR number 60-2-098, is renamed the Child Care and
Development Trust Fund.

Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2000.

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STATEMENT OF SUBSTANTIAL CHANGES CONTAINED IN
COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR
Senate Bill 664

The committee substitute removes the Florida Organ and Tissue Donor Trust Fund from the bill which had previously been sunset July 1, 1999, pursuant to Chapter 96-418, Laws of Florida.
