Section 322.2617, Florida Statutes, is 14 created to read: 15 322.2617 Driver license notification required prior to 16 suspension. -- In addition to any other requirement provided for 17 in this chapter or in any provision of the Florida Statutes with respect to the suspension or revocation of a driver 18 license, prior to the suspension or revocation of a driver 19

license, the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles
must first send a registered letter to the address on the
person's current driver license, providing that person with a
30-day notice of the reason or reasons for the suspension or
revocation together with instructions on what the person may
do to avoid the suspension or revocation, if possible. No
suspension or revocation of a driver license shall take effect
until 30 days from the date that the registered letter is
delivered, or notice is received indicating that the problem
requiring a revocation or suspension has been resolved.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.

HOUSE SUMMARY Requires notification by registered letter to a person whose driver license is about to be suspended or revoked and prohibits such suspension or revocation until 30 days after receipt of the registered letter. See bill for details.
