Subsection (3) of section 877.04, Florida 13 Statutes, is amended to read: 877.04 Tattooing prohibited; penalty .--14 (3) No body of a minor shall be tattooed without the 15 16 written notarized consent of the parent or legal quardian. No 17 body of a minor under the age of 16 shall be tattooed unless the minor is accompanied by a parent or legal guardian. 18 Section 2. <u>Tattooing</u> industry sunrise review.--It is 19 20 the intent of the Legislature that no profession or occupation 21 be subject to regulation by the state unless the regulation is 22 necessary to protect the public health, safety, or welfare 23 from significant and discernible harm or damage. Therefore, pursuant to s. 11.62, Florida Statutes, a sunrise review shall 24 be conducted to determine the need to regulate the tattooing 25 26 industry. The recommendations of the review shall be submitted to the Legislature on or before February 1, 2001. The 27 28 proponents of this regulation and the agency of jurisdiction 29 shall assist in conducting the review. Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2000. 30 31
