Amendment (with directory language and title amendments)

On page 2, between lines 13 and 14, of the bill

insert: (3) Any student whose parent or guardian makes written request to the school principal shall be exempted from the teaching of reproductive health or any disease, ~~including HIV/AIDS~~, its symptoms, development, and treatment, including HIV/AIDS, mental and emotional disorders, and mental illness.

A student so exempted may not be penalized by reason of that exemption. Course descriptions for comprehensive health education shall not interfere with the local determination of appropriate curriculum which reflects local values and concerns.
