Section 261.11, Florida Statutes, is 10 created to read: 261.11 The Off-Highway-Vehicle Revolving Trust 11 12 Fund. -- There is created the Off-Highway-Vehicle Revolving Trust Fund to be administered by the Division of Forestry 13 14 within the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services. (1) The trust fund shall consist of deposits from the 15 16 following sources: 17 (a) Fees paid to the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles for the titling and registration of off-highway 18 19 vehicles. 20 (b) Revenues and income from any other source required 21 by law or as appropriated by the Legislature to be deposited 22 into the fund. 23 (c) Donations from private sources. 24 (d) Interest earned on moneys on deposit in the fund. 25 (2) Moneys in the fund shall be available for 26 recommended allocation by the Off-Highway-Vehicle Recreation 27 Advisory Committee and the Department of Agriculture and 28 Consumer Services and upon annual appropriation by the Legislature, exclusively for the following: 29 30 (a) Implementation of the Off-Highway-Vehicle 31 Recreation Program by the Department of Agriculture and 1

1 Consumer Services, which includes personnel and other related expenses, administrative and operating expenses, expenses 2 3 related to safety, training, and rider-education programs, and, if funds are available, acquisition of lands to be 4 5 included in the Off-Highway-Vehicle Recreation Program's б system of lands and trails and the management and maintenance 7 of such lands. 8 (b) Approved grants to governmental agencies and entities that wish to provide off-highway-vehicle recreation 9 10 areas or trails for public use. 11 (c) Matching funds to be used to match off-highway-vehicle recreation grant funds available from 12 other sources, including grant funds available pursuant to the 13 federal Recreational Trails Program. 14 (3) Notwithstanding s. 216.301 and pursuant to s. 15 216.351, any balance in the trust fund at the end of any 16 17 fiscal year shall remain therein and shall be available for 18 the purposes set out in this section and as otherwise provided 19 by law. (4) Pursuant to s. 19(f)(2), Art. III of the State 20 Constitution, the Off-Highway-Vehicle Revolving Trust Fund, 21 unless terminated sooner, shall be terminated on July 1, 2004. 22 However, before its scheduled termination, the 23 24 Off-Highway-Vehicle Revolving Trust Fund shall be reviewed as 25 provided in s. 215.3206(1) and (2). Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2000, 26 but it shall not take effect unless it is enacted by at least 27 28 a three-fifths vote of the membership of each house of the 29 Legislature. 30 31
