A bill to be entitled
An act relating to dangerous dogs; amending s.
767.14, F.S.; deleting certain restrictions
relating to the regulation of dangerous dogs;
expanding applicability of provisions
authorizing local restrictions; providing an
effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 767.14, Florida Statutes, is
amended to read:

767.14 Additional local restrictions
authorized.--Nothing in this act shall limit any local
government from placing further restrictions or additional
requirements on owners of dangerous dogs or developing
procedures and criteria for the implementation of this act,
provided that ~~no such regulation is specific to breed and that~~
the provisions of this act are not lessened by such additional
regulations or requirements. ~~This section shall not apply to
any local ordinance adopted prior to October 1, 1990.~~

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2000.

SENATE SUMMARY

Deletes a provision that prohibits local governments from
enacting breed-specific regulations regarding dangerous
dogs. Expands the applicability of provisions authorizing
local restrictions to include local ordinances adopted
before October 1, 1990.
