13	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

15	Section 1. The Legislature recognizes the need for
16	statewide solid and hazardous waste management assistance to
17	Florida's private businesses, industries, and the public
18	sector, including local units of government. In order to
19	assist the Department of Environmental Protection in providing
20	solid and hazardous waste management assistance to Florida's
21	public and private sectors on a continuing basis, the
22	Legislature recognizes the need for a waste exchange as part
23	of the state's comprehensive solid waste and hazardous waste
24	management programs and designates Southern Waste Information
25	Exchange, Inc., a nonprofit Florida 501(c)(3) organization, to
26	provide this service to Florida's private and public sectors.
27	The Department of Environmental Protection shall include in
28	its annual legislative budget request pursuant to section
29	216.023, Florida Statutes, funding for the Southern Waste
30	Information Exchange, Inc. The amount of the funding to be
31	included in the legislative budget request shall be based on
