HB 735 redesignates the "Key Largo Hammocks State Botanical Site" as the "Dagney Johnson Key Largo Hammocks State Botanical Site."

The bill becomes effective upon becoming law.

There appears to be no direct fiscal impact on state or local governments.

*(On May 3, 2000 the House adopted the bill by a vote of 114 Yeas 0 Nays. On May 5, 2000 HB 735 died in the Senate Committee on Natural Resources.)*
