Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 23, between lines 9 and 10,

insert:

Section 22. Effective July 1, 2000, subsection (8) of section 316.614, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

316.614 Safety belt usage.--

(8) Any person who violates the provisions of this section commits a nonmoving violation, punishable as provided in chapter 318. A law enforcement officer may not search or inspect a motor vehicle, its contents, the driver, or a passenger solely because of a violation of this section.

~~However, except for violations of s. 316.613, enforcement of this section by state or local law enforcement agencies must be accomplished only as a secondary action when a driver of a motor vehicle has been detained for a suspected violation of another section of this chapter, chapter 320, or chapter 322.~~
