Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 11, lines 30 and 31, delete those lines

and insert:

(d) A school district may not use any portion of the annual allocation on the following, except for growth of student membership or maintenance needs, until all instructional materials in the core courses of the subject areas of mathematics, language arts, science, social studies, reading, and literature for kindergarten through grade 12 have been purchased:

1. The purchase of instructional materials pursuant to paragraph (3)(b), including library and reference books and nonprint materials, which are not on the state-adopted list.

2. The purchase of instructional materials pursuant to paragraph (3)(c) for kindergarten and first grade which are not on the state-adopted list.

3. The purchase of instructional materials or other items, pursuant to subsection (4), having intellectual content
