The Committee on Transportation offered the following:

Amendment (with title amendment)

remove from the bill: Everything after the enacting clause
and insert in lieu thereof:

Section 1. Excess revenue from civil penalties imposed for traffic violations.--If any municipality or county receives more than 25 percent of its total actual annual revenue for the prior fiscal year from civil penalties collected from traffic violations, any amount in excess of 25 percent shall be sent to the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles to be distributed in the following manner:

(1) Fifty percent shall be deposited into the Highway Safety Operating Trust Fund.

(2) Fifty percent shall be deposited into the Brain and Spinal Cord Injury Rehabilitation Trust Fund.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2000.
