On page 3, line 24, of the bill

insert:

Section 1. SECRETARY OF BARBECUE.--

(1) The position of Secretary of Barbecue is created within the Executive Office of the Governor. The Secretary of Barbecue shall be appointed by the Governor for a 1-year term. The Secretary of Barbecue shall be a ceremonial position. The secretary shall serve without compensation.

(2) The Secretary of Barbecue, or the secretary's designee, shall represent the Governor in functions promoting the enjoyment of barbecue and shall promote the diversity of barbecue created by the many cultures represented in the state's diverse citizenry. No state funds shall be used for the support of this position.
