A bill to be entitled 1 An act relating to state law enforcement 2 3 officers; providing a short title; declaring 4 public policy; requiring the Department of 5 Management Services to develop a plan to increase the salary ranges for all law 6 7 enforcement classes; providing guidelines; 8 providing an appropriation; providing an 9 effective date. 10 11 WHEREAS, the protection of persons and property is among the highest responsibilities of government, and 12 13 WHEREAS, the encouragement of public safety professionalism provides for the long-term respect for and 14 stability of our public institutions, and 15 16 WHEREAS, the recruitment and retention of sworn law 17 enforcement professionals is a responsibility that this state 18 should not shirk, and 19 WHEREAS, this state has not kept pace with other public 20 employers in recognizing the valuable service such officers provide their communities, and 21 WHEREAS, this state's residents and visitors reap the 22 23 rewards of a sustained reduction in reported crime rates for 24 which a tangible recognition is appropriate, NOW, THEREFORE, 25 26 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida: 27 28 This act may be cited as the "Law Section 1. 29 Enforcement Dignity 2000 Act." 30 It is the public policy of this state to Section 2. provide a market-based, continuously competitive salary for

full-time certified law enforcement officers who are employed in public safety occupations by the state and defined in s. 943.10(1), (2), and (3), Florida Statutes.

Section 3. The Department of Management Services shall develop a plan to invest additional resources in upgrading the minimum and maximum salary ranges for all certified law enforcement classes employed by the state and defined in section 2, beginning July 1, 2000, as follows:

- (1) The minimum and maximum salary ranges for all certified law enforcement classes shall be adjusted, for fiscal year 2000-2001, in an amount consistent with the recommendations contained in the Law Enforcement Advisory Committee Salary Recommendation Final Report, dated December 8, 1999, issued pursuant to the requirements of Specific Appropriation 1933A of the 1999-2000 General Appropriations Act.
- (2) For fiscal year 2001-2002 and thereafter, the

 Department of Management Services shall develop a compensation

 package sufficient to grant the cash equivalent of a one-step

 increase to the covered classes.
- (3) Funds to implement this act shall be supplemental to additional salary provided to state employees in the General Appropriations Act or other legislation implementing that act.
- (4) In calculating the amounts required to fund this act, the Department of Management Services shall continuously require that the salary of law enforcement officers employed by the state be equal to the average salary of the equivalent positions in the 10 most populous municipalities in this state.

Section 4. There is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund the sum of \$25,850,000 to provide a \$5,000 adjustment to the salaries and associated benefits of certified law enforcement officers employed by the state and defined in section 2. Section 5. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
