Notwithstanding any provision of law to the 24 contrary, a law enforcement officer, as defined in s. 25 26 943.10(1), who is going to or coming from work in an official 27 law enforcement vehicle shall be deemed to be engaged in a 28 special errand or mission for the respective employer. 29 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a 30 law. 31
