Section 1. Anatomical gifts by inmates.--The
Department of Corrections shall provide each person remanded
to the custody of the department the opportunity to obtain an
anatomical gift donor card as provided in s. 732.914, Florida
Statutes. Nothing in this section shall be construed to
confer a right on the part of an inmate under the supervision
of the Department of Corrections or any private correctional
facility contracted by the Department of Corrections to make
an anatomical gift. Any claim or action filed on behalf of an
inmate which seeks to enforce an alleged right to make or
donate an anatomical gift is a nullity and shall be summarily
dismissed with prejudice by the court in which the action or
claim is filed.
